8 9 WHEREAS, ML&P, University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) and Providence Hospital are preparing to develop a combined heat and power project to be located in the U-Med district for the benefit of the three organizations. The project will contain one or two gas turbine generators each with a heat recovery boiler and a thermal distribution system that will connect Providence Hospital and UAA buildings to the plant.

WHEREAS, ML&P and UAA intend to apply for \$35,000,000 in grant monies as partial funding for the design and construction of a combined heat and power project with a current estimated design and construction cost of approximately \$55,000,000.

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER UTILITY (ML&P) TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA ENERGY AUTHORITY TO FUND THE DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION OF A COMBINED HEAT AND POWER

PROJECT

In 2008, the Alaska State legislature established in Alaska Statute 42.45.045, a Renewable Energy Grant Fund and Recommendation Program to provide funding to renewable energy projects throughout Alaska. A cogeneration project may qualify for a grant under this program.

The University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA), Providence Hospital and ML&P have long been interested in developing a cogeneration project that would provide electric power to ML&P and heat in the form of steam to Providence Hospital and UAA. By using the waste heat from a turbogenerator to produce steam, the two products (steam and electric energy) can be produced using just over half of the energy needed to produce the two products independently. However, the opportunities to do this are limited by the need to use both forms of energy simultaneously and to use the steam within a fairly short distance from its production. The U-Med district presents one of the best opportunities in Anchorage to do this.

A grant under the Renewable Energy Grant Fund and Recommendation Program could render this project economic for all three of the interested parties. Application for a grant under this program requires authorization from the applicant's governing body, submission of the grant application, and identification of a point of contact who is authorized to submit the application. This Assembly Resolution is requested to fulfill these application requirements.

 This project, if developed with an adequate grant from the Renewable Energy Grant Fund, has the potential to reduce ML&P's total cost of power production, reduce the cost of heat for both Providence Hospital and UAA, and reduce the discharge of carbon dioxide and other pollutants into the atmosphere from the production of electric power used by ML&P and steam used by Providence Hospital and UAA.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF THIS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ML&P TO APPLY WITH UAA FOR A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA ENERGY AUTHORITY TO PARTIALLY FUND THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A COGENERATION PLANT IN THE U-MED DISTRICT.
