SECTION 2.

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385 and AMC 19.90 mandate that when a water main extension will create, or has the potential of creating, any charge or assessment against the adjacent property, the water main extension may not be constructed unless the legislative body of each municipality through which the extension passes has approved the extension; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) plans to construct a water main extension in the public rights-of-way of Jade Street and West 84th Avenue in Anchorage, Alaska.

WHEREAS, the extension of the water main will specially benefit and provide water service to twenty-nine (29) properties previously not benefited, and in doing so will create potential assessments against them; and

WHEREAS, at its November 5, 2008 meeting the AWWU Authority Board supported this resolution, now, therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. It is in the best interest of the community that said water main improvements proceed.

AWWU shall keep an accurate account of all costs of the water main improvements.

The Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) plans to construct a water main extension in the public rights-of-way of Jade Street and West 84th Avenue in Anchorage, Alaska. Past attempts to construct water facilities in the Sand Lake Area through the improvement district process have failed over the years. As a result property owners and the Municipality petitioned state and federal legislative representatives to appropriate funds for construction of water facilities. The Sand Lake Area Water Extension utilizes grant money provided by both the State of Alaska and the Federal Government. The project provides necessary infrastructure to facilitate future service expansion at the desire of adjacent property owners. The water extension alignment will make water service available to twenty-nine (29) parcels where water service is currently unavailable.

Initially, all costs to construct the proposed water main extension shall be born by AWWU. When these newly benefited and previously un-assessed parcels connect to the water main, AWWU shall recover a pro-rated share of its costs through the Levy Upon Connection assessment procedures as authorized by the current Municipal Codes and Utility Tariff.

34 35 The properties benefiting from proposed construction, and subject to future assessments and charges, are identified on the proposed assessment roll, which is made part of the resolution carried by this memorandum. The estimated assessments for each parcel have been calculated in consideration of grant appropriations. As each previously un-assessed property seeks connection, the parcel's pro-rated share of assessable water main costs will be presented to the Assembly for confirmation of levy action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AWWU Tariff in effect at the time of connection.


