16 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**
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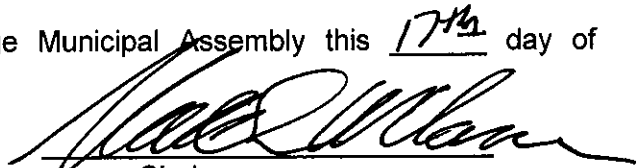
18 **Section 1.** That Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$350,421)

SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$350,421) AS A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, TO AREAWIDE GENERAL CIP FUND (401) FOR SEISMIC SPRINKLER BRACING FOR THE SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT

The attached Assembly Resolution appropriates \$350,421, as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for Seismic Sprinkler Bracing for the Seismic Retrofit project. The work will be accomplished by private contractors under the direct supervision of the Maintenance and Operations Department, Contract Management Section.

The scope of work includes installation of seismic sprinkler bracing for eight facilities for improved resistance to seismic forces.

The grant agreement has been executed by the State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Municipality of Anchorage, effective May 5, 2008. The grant completion date is November 30, 2009.
