The Parks and Recreation Department proposes two recently acquired park properties in the Central and Northeast Park Districts, respectively, be formally dedicated as park land by the Municipal Assembly.

These properties were acquired in 2006 to fulfill needs for neighborhood use park areas identified in the Anchorage Bowl Park, Natural Resource, and Recreation 15 Facility Plan for relatively high-density, underserved neighborhoods. The subject 16 parks are undeveloped areas including portions suitable for neighborhood park development as well as portions of natural open space to preserve. These park lands provide opportunities for long-term recreational use by the community and merit the protection of dedicated status.

Tr. B-2B, Commodore Park Subdivision, in the Central Park District, is primarily a natural area including classified wetlands. The area includes potential connections to link existing trail routes, parks, and residential areas. Upland portions of the park may accommodate a variety of play areas, picnic area, trails, and parking.

Lot 3, Muldoon Estates Subdivision, in the Northeast Park District, includes a segment of Chester Creek. The park has potential for a number of recreational facilities, including play field, playground, picnic area, and parking area. In addition the park has a segment of Chester Creek disturbed by activity under previous ownership. Development of the Park may include restoration and enhancement of this creek corridor.

The Abbott Loop Community Council at its April 24, 2008, regular meeting passed a motion in support of the proposed dedication of Tr. B-2B, Commodore Park Subdivision, located within its area. The Northeast Community Council at its April 17, 37 2008, regular meeting passed a motion in support of the proposed dedication of Lot 38 3, Muldoon Estates Subdivision, located within its area.

40 The Parks and Recreation Commission, at its meeting May 8, 2008, recommended 41 these park lands be formally dedicated.

Section 2 of the ordinance facilitates management of the property consistent with the

44 intent of this dedication. Section 2 provides, notwithstanding AMC section 25.30.020, 45 the Assembly may authorize the grant of utility easements, when such conveyance is 46 found to be of substantial benefit to the respective park.

48 The ordinance has no private sector economic effects; local government effects are 49 less than \$30,000.00, therefore a summary of economic effects is not required and 50 none is attached in accordance with AMC section 2.30.050B.1.b.




