WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) owns land with an alpine trespass hut in the Upper Girdwood Valley in HLB Parcel Nos. 6-282 and 6-292, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, T10N, R2E, Seward Meridian; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2008, the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission unanimously approved HLBAC Resolution 2008-12 supporting a sale and ground lease of municipal land and facilities to Chugach Adventure Guides; and

WHEREAS, the alpine trespass hut causes ongoing liability, nuisance and sanitation issues for the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, sale of the alpine trespass hut to Chugach Adventure Guides eliminates the Municipality's risk of liability and expenditure of HLB staff time and resources due to ongoing management; and

WHEREAS, this disposal provides for Chugach Adventure Guides to be responsible for annual rent established via the Heritage Land Bank fee schedule, any and all taxes, assessments and applicable fees during the lease term; now, therefore.

Notwithstanding any contrary provision of the Anchorage Municipal Code, the Assembly finds it is in the best interest of the Municipality and the public to dispose of this alpine trespass hut and enter into a ground lease with Chugach Adventure Guides on the terms and conditions set forth in the Assembly Memorandum, and hereby waives the requirements in Chapter 25.40 for appraisal and competitive bid process.

This ordinance authorizes the sale of an existing alpine trespass hut and a ground lease to Chugach Adventure Guides (CAG). The hut sits on Heritage Land Bank (HLB) lands in the Girdwood Valley (a portion of HLB Parcel Nos. 6-282 and 6-292, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2, T10N, R2E, Seward Meridian).

The existence and use of the alpine trespass hut by the public puts the Municipality at risk for liability exposure. CAG proposes to purchase the hut for one dollar and lease approximately one acre of land surrounding the hut at market value. CAG plans to use the structure as a warming hut for clients of their backcountry skiing operations.

Selling the hut eliminates the Municipality's risk of trespass liability and responsibility for correcting sanitation problems. The sale also eliminates the ongoing dedication of HLB staff time and resources for management. approved, the lease allows CAG to invest in improving the hut, including sanitation facilities and a reservation system similar to the European hut model for summer hikers.

CAG understands use of the property may be changed in the future. This sale and ground lease do not grant rights or preference for future use of the property. In the event CAG desires to expand the use of the lease area by constructing removable platforms and/or a commercial yurts, those expansion plans for new facilities/improvements must be submitted to the HLB for prior review and approval.

A review of this proposal by all relevant Municipal agencies received no comments and confirmed the proposed disposal is the current optimal (short-term) use of the parcels. At its August 18, 2008 meeting, the Girdwood Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to support a letter of non-objection. Notice of a public hearing at the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission published on September 28, October 5 and October 12, 2008 in the Alaska Business Monthly. After receiving no objections during the public hearing, Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission unanimously approved HLBAC Resolution 2008-12, supporting the sale and lease on October 16, 2008 (see Appendix A).

HLBAC Resolution No. 2008-12 October 16, 2008

ISSUE

Shall the HLB Advisory Commission approve a non-competitive lease and sale of property to Chugach Adventure Guides (CAG) for purposes of maintaining a trespass alpine hut on Heritage Land Bank lands in the Girdwood Valley?

AUTHORITY

AMC 25.40.010: "It is the mission of the Heritage Land Bank to manage uncommitted municipal land and the Heritage Land Bank Fund in a manner designed to benefit the present and future citizens of Anchorage, promote orderly development, and achieve the goals of the Comprehensive Plan."

AMC 25.40.025.A: "The Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission shall hold a public hearing, with public notice as specified in this chapter, prior to making a recommendation to the mayor and assembly regarding the disposal of Heritage Land Bank land or an interest in land. Land disposals under this chapter include land sales, land exchanges, leases, and easements."

BACKGROUND

HLB is the owner of a trespass alpine hut on HLB lands in the upper Girdwood Valley located on HLB Parcel 6-282 AND 6-292. The hut was constructed approximately 15 years ago prior to conveyance to the Municipality, is in poor shape and lacks sanitation facilities. Public use of the hut in summer is occasional and CAG uses the hut in winter for warming and shelter for backcountry skiing clients.

DISCUSSION

The current trespass situation and use of the hut by the public puts the Municipality at risk for liability exposure. CAG has proposed to lease approximately 1 acre of land surrounding the hut at market value and purchase the hut for \$1. Selling the hut will eliminate the Municipality's risk of trespass liability. If approved, the lease will enable CAG to invest in improving the hut, including providing sanitation facilities and a reservation system similar to the European hut model for summer. There is the potential

for CAG to request additional use of the lease area for a commercial yurt rental system for summer users.

The lease document will provide for a five year term, with a five year option and rent adjustment. All risks and liabilities of managing and maintaining the hut will be vested in CAG. The non-competitive lease rental will be established at market value based on the HLB fee schedule.


A review of this proposal by all relevant Municipal agencies received no comments and confirmed that the proposed disposal is the current optimal (short-term) use of the parcels. Public notice of this hearing was published September 28, October 5 and October 12, 2008 in the Alaska Business Monthly.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of proposed HLB Resolution 2008-12, recommending to the Anchorage Assembly that HLB execute a lease and sale with Chugach Adventure Guides for purposes of improving and maintaining an existing alpine hut on HLB lands in the Girdwood Valley.

WHEREAS, "It is the mission of the Heritage Land Bank to manage uncommitted municipal land ... to benefit the present and future citizens of Anchorage, promote orderly development, and achieve the goals of the comprehensive plan." (AMC 25.40.010); and,

WHEREAS, land disposals under AMC 25.40.025.F include land sales, land exchanges, leases, and easements; and,

WHEREAS, Chugach Adventure Guides has applied for a non-competitive, market value lease for use of HLB land and purchase of the trespass hut for maintenance of the hut in the upper Girdwood Valley including portions of HLB Parcel Nos. 6-282, and 6-292; and,

WHEREAS, Chugach Adventure Guides will accept all responsibility for the trespass hut, including improvements and liability; and,

WHEREAS, a short term lease of five years, with a five year option will provide enough surety for Chugach Adventure Guides to invest in the hut and land improvements, but Chugach Adventure Guides understands that the lease will not give them any preferential treatment at the end of the term of the lease; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Municipality to dispose of the hut and lease the property in order to reduce liability and to work with a lessee to improve the hut and related sanitation issues.

NOW THEREFORE THE HERITAGE LAND BANK ADVISORY COMMISSION RESOLVES TO RECOMMEND THE APPROVAL OF A LEASE AND SALE, SUBJECT TO:
