On March 17, 2009 the Municipality of Anchorage's Office of Management and Budget notified the Anchorage School District of the final population 5-year average to be used in the calculation of the tax cap limitation. The population 5-year average was adjusted from an estimated 1.1 percent to 0.9 percent. On March 19, 2009 the Anchorage School District received notification that the new construction amount changed from the preliminary projection used in computing the Municipality's tax limitation increased from \$396,945,272 to \$460,064,618. These two changes combine for an additional \$80,935 under the tax cap limitation for the Anchorage School District from what was submitted on AO NO. 2009-17.

The School Board requested that the FY 2009-2010 Proposed Financial Plan be introduced to the Municipality of Anchorage Assembly on March 3, 2009 (scheduled for Public Hearing on March 24, 2009). The accompanying memorandum AM 73-2009 provided the assumptions taken into consideration in preparation of the FY 2009-2010 Proposed Financial Plan. However, as a result of the timing of the notification of final population 5-year average and new construction amounts, the upper limit of the budget and tax request was not adjusted prior to submission of AO NO. 2009-17 and AM 73-2009.

The District is submitting the attached "S" version to AO NO. 2009-17 to reflect the above changes in the population 5-year average and new construction. AO NO. 2009-17(S) increases the upper limit of the School District's budget from \$762,833,890 to \$762,914,825, an increase of \$80,935 and also increases the local tax contribution from \$232,947,582 to \$233,028,517, an increase of \$80,935. With approval of AO NO. 2009-17(S), the District will make the necessary adjustments to the FY 2009-2010 Proposed Financial Plan in June when final funding is clarified by the State and/or any other funding agencies.

The District is still waiting for final figures related to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. This item will directly affect the upper limit of the School District's budget, which may require further approval by the Anchorage School Board and the Anchorage Assembly.

The Anchorage School District proposed a tight, balanced budget that was responsive to the needs of our community and our students. The School Board conducted a thorough review and public process. The ASD budget presented to the Assembly for approval is responsible and appropriate. In its discussion of the school district budget, the Assembly did not offer specific or meaningful reasons to cut the budget. Absent such specific reasons, we are left with cuts for the sake of cutting. The children and families of Anchorage deserve better than this. I am vetoing the Assembly resolution because I support the balanced budget as presented by the School District.
