AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE RATE OF TAX LEVY, APPROVING THE
AMOUNT OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY TAX, AND LEVYING TAXES FOR THE
ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR TAX YEAR 2009

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Assembly hereby fixes the rate of tax levy for the Anchorage School
District for tax year 2009. The Anchorage Assembly levies this tax upon the full value of
all assessed taxable real and personal property, as follows:


Areawide Schools	a tax of 7.18 mills
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Section 2. The property tax amount approved for 2009 (within the meaning of the tax
increase limitation ("tax cap") provision of the Charter, Section 14.03) is:

Anchorage School District	\$225,459,645
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Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and
approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

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9 This memorandum transmits the ordinance to establish the 2009 tax rate and tax levy for
10 the ASD. The ASD tax rate and tax levy are based on the amount of property taxes
11 required to support the ASD operating budget in calendar year 2009. These reflect one
12 half of the property taxes required for ASD's revised fiscal year 2008-2009 operating
13 budget, and one half of the property taxes required for ASD's fiscal year 2009-2010
14 operating budget.
