Shall Anchorage Municipal Charter Article XVII, Section 17.01, Equal Rights, be amended to read:

# Article XVII General Provisions.

Section 17.01. Equal rights.

The assembly shall enact ordinances against invidious discrimination in housing, public accommodations, employment, education, and financing practices on the basis of race, religion, age, sex, color, national origin, marital status, **sexual orientation**, or physical disability.
