AN ORDINANCE WAIVING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 3.30.179 AND 3.30.168, EMPLOYMENT OF RELATIVES, FOR APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF MARK HALL TO CHIEF, ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the provisions of Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.30.168, applicable to executive employees pursuant to section 3.30.179, prohibit appointment of an agency head where relatives are employed by the agency; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Fire Department employs two persons related to Mark Hall, the Mayor's selection for Fire Chief, Anchorage Fire Department, a nephew employed as a firefighter/EMT in the Fire Division, and a nephew employed as an engineer/paramedic in the EMS division; and

WHEREAS, safeguards can be implemented in the Anchorage Fire Department to avoid direct supervision of relatives by the Fire Chief, provide for re-evaluation of the effects of the relationship by the Municipal Manager, the Fire Chief's direct supervisor, and the Employee Relations director, and do not prohibit later corrective action, if appropriate and in the best interests of the Municipality; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

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Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.30.168, prohibiting employment of relatives, and applicable to executive employees pursuant to section 3.30.179, is hereby waived, subject to the conditions set out herein, for the Mayor's appointment of Mark Hall as Chief of Anchorage Fire Department.

<u>Section 2.</u> This waiver is conditioned on the Fire Chief avoiding any direct supervision of the two relatives employed by Anchorage Fire Department, and delegation of any financial or promotion decisions to a deputy chief.

<u>Section 3.</u> This waiver is conditioned on re-evaluation and approval of the continued employment relationship, pursuant to section 3.30.168 C., every 6 months by the Municipal Manager and the Employee Relations Director.

<u>Section 4.</u> This waiver shall not prohibit a later determination the relationship is not in the best interests of the Municipality, or corrective action pursuant to section 3.30.168 E.

Subject: AN ORDINANCE WAIVING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE

SECTIONS 3.30.179 AND 3.30.168, EMPLOYMENT OF RELATIVES, FOR APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF MARK HALL TO CHIEF, ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

The Mayor selected Mark Hall for appointment as Fire Chief of the Anchorage Fire Department (AFD). AFD currently employs two persons related to Mark Hall; a nephew employed as a firefighter/EMT in the Fire Division, and a nephew employed as an engineer/paramedic in the EMS division.

Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.30.168, applicable to executives under section 3.30.179, prohibits the employment of relatives where an employee is the agency head. If confirmed by the Assembly, Mark Hall becomes the Anchorage Fire Department agency head.

To safeguard the interests of the Fire Department and the Municipality, conditions to the waiver are proposed by the Mayor, including the Fire Chief shall have no direct supervision over the relatives, and any financial or promotion decisions related to the relatives shall be delegated to a deputy fire chief. In addition, the continued employment relationship shall be subject to re-evaluation every six months by the Municipal Manager, and Fire Chief's direct supervisor, and the Employee Relations Director. If the Municipal Manager and the Employee Relations Director determine the relationship is not in the best interests of the Municipality, corrective action shall be taken pursuant to section 3.30.168 E.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL OF AN ORDINANCE WAIVING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 3.30.179 AND 3.30.168, EMPLOYMENT OF RELATIVES, FOR APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF MARK HALL TO CHIEF, ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT.
