Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Charter section 5.02(c), I hereby line item veto the following items in Anchorage Ordinance No. 2009-117, an ordinance adopting the 2010 general government capital improvement budget, and Anchorage Resolution 2009-242, a resolution of the Municipality of Anchorage approving the 2010-2015 general government capital improvement program:

Pine Street/4th Avenue Area Storm Reconstruction - \$3,200,000

In developing the Administration's proposal we carefully balanced priorities within a framework of how much we thought voters would be willing to support and concluded the road bond needed to be less than \$40 million. The Assembly amendment moved the Pine Street project to 2010 from the originally proposed year of 2011. This action increased the road package total by nearly ten percent.

Anchorage's economy is in a delicate balance. I believe we must proceed cautiously in the overall dollar amount of bond proposals that ultimately are placed before voters next April. Because of this and a concern that this increase could jeopardize the rest of the bond package by exceeding a level I believe Anchorage voters are more likely to approve, I have vetoed the funding for this project. I will, however, commit to include the project in the capital improvement budget and plan for Fiscal Year 2011.

Override Failed 12-15-09

Sand Lake Ambulance - \$250,000

The Assembly amendment moved this project from FY 2011 to FY 2010. In addition to purchasing the ambulance, the Anchorage Fire Department will require an estimated \$750,000 in operating costs each year to staff it. We do not have the operating funds or the personnel to operate another ambulance during FY 2010. For this reason, the equipment purchase is unwarranted at this time.
