AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF AN EXCLUSIVE USE PERMIT TO THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD FOR PORTIONS OF LOTS 9-A AND 12-B IN THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE SUBDIVISION.

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The United States Coast Guard (USCG) established a Maritime Safety and Security Team on Port of Anchorage property in 2004 to fulfill its operational mission in the State of Alaska. Their presence consists of three sites under an Exclusive Use Permit; the Coast Guard requests two sites be renewed in 2009.

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Although the USCG continues to require area at the Port of Anchorage (POA) to store materials and equipment necessary to fulfill its mission, they requested a reduction of 86,850 square feet on the main equipment storage site, Lot 12-B, from 111,600 square feet to 24,750. The square footage for Lot 9-A remains unchanged. The original five-year (5) Exclusive Use Permit was approved by the Municipal Assembly on September 21, 2004 per Assembly Ordinance 2004-127. Following are the proposed Exclusive Use Permit Renewal salient terms:

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**United States Coast Guard** Permittee:

Permit Area:

Portions of Lot 9-A (11,700 sf) and Lot 12-B (24,750 sf) in the Port of Anchorage Subdivision, totaling approximately 36,450 square feet.

**Ground Fee:** 

The total annual fee for the permitted areas increases from \$.88 per square foot to \$1.31 per square foot for a total of Forty-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars (\$47,749.00) per year, payable monthly at Three Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$3,979.00).

Fee Adjustment:

The fee for the permitted area is adjusted every 5 years to market rate; an appraisal was completed May 29, 2009 and is reflected in the ground fee above, so no further rate adjustment is required.

33 Permit Length: 34

Renewal for one (1) year; four one-year options remain.

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Permittee services: Permittee is solely responsible for all costs connected with the installation, operation, maintenance, and replacement of all Government-owned equipment located on the permitted premises.

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Snow removal and ice control service for permit areas, **POA Services:** 

40 41 42 provided the permit areas are not access-restricted by USCG. POA shall also provide security service and debris removal.

Electric power shall only be provided to Lot 9-A.

The reduction in revenue resulting from the reduction in square footage utilized by the Coast Guard is mitigated by Horizon Lines' request to increase the size of their storage area to include the vacated square footage as well as small pockets of currently unused transit storage.
