COSTS.

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This ordinance increases public transportation fares for users of the fixed route (People Mover) and demand responsive (AnchorRIDES) systems. The higher fares provide \$240,000 annually in additional program income to help offset increases in costs and avoid further cuts in service.

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The Federal Transit Administration requires a reduced fare of not more than 50% of the peak hour fare be available to persons with disabilities, Medicare card holders and seniors. The increase in the reduced fare is consistent with this requirement.

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A review of 46 other public transportation systems shows the Municipality's current fares are higher than average for adult and youth cash and monthly adult passes, and lower than average for reduced fares (cash, day passes, and monthly passes) for senior citizens and people with disabilities.

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The Americans with Disabilities Act limits the fare amount charged to disabled (ADA) clients for demand response systems (AnchorRIDES) to two times the current fixed route fare. The current fixed route fare for adults is \$1.75 and the proposed fare is \$2.00. Proposed ADA and senior fare donations increase from \$3.00 to \$4.00; this is the maximum allowed by federal ADA requirements.

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This ordinance also eliminates the 2 for 1 Program, allowing non-profit organizations to purchase fares at a 50% discount.
