11.70.060 TO INCREASE EXISTING FARES IN THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 11.70.060 is hereby amended to
read as follows:

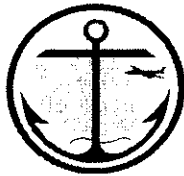
The total estimated annual increase will result in additional annual amount of \$240,000 to fund increases in operating costs.

8 The S version of the ordinance retracts the proposed fare increases of the original
9 ordinance, but retains the amendment to eliminate the 2 for 1 program, where local
10 social service (non-profit) agencies can purchase People Mover fares at a 50%
11 discount, up to \$1,000 annually. This change will generate an additional \$125,000 in
12 revenues to help offset increases in costs and avoid further cuts in service.
