Section 2. The Assembly authorizes the municipality to convey a non-exclusive 30 foot wide radius landscape easement centered on Electrical Structure #32-2, Station 19+37, as described on the CEA construction plans for project #E0850100, Anchorage Substation to Baxter Lake Substation.

Easement area contains 1,800 square feet more or less.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.


