3 4 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has a projected budget deficit in excess 5 of \$17 Million for 2009; and WHEREAS, under the 2009 Municipal Budget, \$13,200 has been allotted for food and meals for the Anchorage Assembly when convening for Assembly business, such as Assembly meetings and Assembly work sessions; and 10 11 WHEREAS, members of the Anchorage Assembly receive an annual stipend of \$30,118.40, approved by the Commission on Salaries and Emoluments under §5.08 of the Charter and paid bi-weekly, as also included in the 2009 Municipal Budget; and 15 WHEREAS, to balance the 2009 Municipal Budget, the Municipality of Anchorage is 16 required to make spending reductions; and WHEREAS, in shouldering a burden currently carried by municipal taxpayers, the Anchorage Assembly fully supports and joins this budget reduction process to identify and 20 participate in reducing the 2009 Municipal Budget; 21 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves: The cost for food and meals for the Anchorage Assembly shall be 25 Section 1. funded from the annual stipend approved by the Commission on Salaries and Emoluments under §5.08 of the Charter. Effective in the first stipend payment following passage and approval Section 2. of AR 2009-36, the bi-weekly deduction of \$46.15 shall be made from 30 each Assembly member's stipend payment, for a yearly contribution of \$1,200 per Assembly member.
