A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING INCLUSION OF UPDATED COST ESTIMATES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE 2009 ALASKA LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM CAPITAL REQUEST FOR FLOODING IN EAGLE RIVER.

WHEREAS, the Eagle Glen East Subdivision has experienced flooding problems for nearly twenty years, with a marked worsening of conditions, as Eagle River has undergone more development; and

WHEREAS, area legislators were successful in securing funding for an engineering study of the problems and conditions; and

WHEREAS, an independent engineering study, closely examining the situation, has been recently completed and accepted by the Municipality, with long term solution cost estimates forecasted to range between \$3.4 and \$4 Million; and

WHEREAS, these long term engineered solutions and cost estimates have been reviewed and discussed in two recent community meetings, including discussions held with area legislators; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly approved inclusion of a project to fix the flooding in the Municipality Of Anchorage 2009 Alaska Legislative Program capital requests; and

WHEREAS, the initial estimate of \$700,000, is now shown to be inadequate; and

WHEREAS, area legislators have requested that the Municipality of Anchorage 2009 Alaska Legislative Program capital request include the updated cost information to fund the long term solution;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:

The Municipality of Anchorage 2009 Alaska Legislative Request requires amendment to update cost estimates for the Eagle Glen East Subdivision flooding to reflect a range between \$3.4 and \$4 Million, as determined by the recently completed engineering study.
