This appropriation will provide the 16 funding necessary to continue air quality monitoring, enforcement and planning activities 17 from January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009. 18 19 The Department of Health and Human Services operates an air quality program consistent 20 with federal, state and local regulations. Staff maintains an ambient air monitoring system 21 for carbon monoxide and particulate matter, enforces local code, issues air quality operating 22 permits, responds to air quality complaints, analyzes air quality data, and issues air quality 23 reports and advisories.
