A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, ACCEPTING FIVE STATE OF ALASKA DRINKING WATER FUND LOAN AGREEMENTS IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TWO SIXTY NINE **THOUSAND DOLLARS** (\$2,269,000) FINANCING A PORTION OF THE COSTS OF THE JUNEAU 21ST WATER UPGRADE, ISLAND-KODIAK-KALGIN WATER UPGRADE, TWO WAY RADIO UPGRADE-WATER, 3000 ARCTIC HVAC UPGRADE, AND 68<sup>TH</sup> **AVENUE REDHAWK INTERTIE PROJECTS** 

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WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of said loans are contained in the Alaska Drinking 38 39 Water Fund Loan Agreements between the Municipality and DEC; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska (the "State") has, pursuant to Alaska Statutes 46.03.032 and 18 AAC 76.005 et seq. of the Alaska Administrative Code, established the Alaska Drinking Water Fund (the "Fund"), a fund which makes use of U.S. Government grants as authorized by the Drinking Water Act, as amended by P.L. 104-182; and,

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (the "Municipality") is eligible to borrow from the Fund for the purposes of planning, designing, constructing, equipping, modifying, improving and expanding public water treatment, transmission and distribution facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Municipality, in its Ordinance No. AO 2007-127 and AO 2008-11, determined it was necessary to proceed to plan, design, develop, construct, equip, acquire property for, or otherwise obtain items of capital improvements in connection with the 2007 and 2008 Capital Improvement Budget projects; authorized the borrowing from the Fund for the purpose of financing a portion of the cost of said projects; and authorized and directed the General Manager of the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility ("AWWU") to complete and submit to the State Department of Environmental Conservation ("DEC") applications to borrow money from the Fund and to negotiate with DEC the terms of such loans; and,

WHEREAS, AWWU has submitted applications for loans in connection with said projects, said applications for these loans have been approved, and AWWU has negotiated the terms of these loans from the Fund in the aggregate amount of \$2,269,000 to finance a portion of the costs of the Juneau 21st Water Upgrade, Island-Kodiak-Kalgin Water Upgrade, Two Way Radio Upgrade-Water, 3000 Arctic HVAC Upgrade, and 68th Avenue Redhawk Intertie projects; and,

WHEREAS, it is hereby found to be in the best interest of the Municipality that terms of said loan offers be approved and that the Loan Agreements be executed on behalf of the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, at its March 5, 2009 meeting, the AWWU Authority Board supported this resolution to accept funding from said loan agreements for these projects; now, therefore,

#### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Loan Proceeds</u>: The subject loan proceeds in the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$2,269,000) are hereby accepted.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Loan Terms</u>: The following primary terms of the loans are among those incorporated in the Loan Agreements as hereby specifically approved:

Principal Amount: Not to exceed \$2,269,000 (subject to individual draws)

Interest Rate: 1.5% per annum

Interest Accrual: Accrual of interest will begin one year after the date of the first disbursement to the Municipality

Term: Twenty years from the date of initiation of operation of the Projects

Date of First Payment: One year following substantial completion and initiation of operation of the Projects

Payment Interval: Annual

Amortization Schedule: Level, fully amortizing

Security: A subordinate lien pledge of the Gross Revenues less the Operating Expenses of the System as those terms are defined in Ordinance No. AO No. 99-118(S), provided that if such monies are not sufficient, repayment of the loans shall be from any legally available funds accruing to or in the possession of the Municipality; and provided further that repayment of the loans is not a direct obligation of the Municipality and neither the faith and credit nor the taxing power of the Municipality are pledged therefore.

 Section 3. Approval and Executing of Loan Agreement: The loan offers are approved and the General Manager and Chief Financial Officer of AWWU, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver the Loan Agreements for and on behalf of the Municipality, including necessary counterparts, and, from and after the executing and delivery of the Loan Agreements, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all such acts and things as may be necessary to carry out and comply with the provisions of the Loan Agreements as executed.










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Island - Kodiak - Kalgin Water Upgrade

Project Map Area


