**SUBJECT:** Appropriation of Two Hundred Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$207,700) From a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Grant to the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) Under the Municipal Traffic Department for the Alaska Safe Routes to School Project

An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate Two Hundred Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$207,700) from an ADOT&PF FHWA Grant to the MOA to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) under the Municipal Traffic Department for the Alaska Safe Routes to School Project. There is no local match requirement for this grant. The grant agreement expires on March 11, 2011.

The Alaska Safe Routes to School Project is being coordinated with multiple partners including the Anchorage Police Department, Community Councils, Anchorage School District, Hazardous Routes Committee, Parent Teacher Associations, and others. This project will assess the condition of all Anchorage School District student walking routes to include lighting, sidewalk/trail condition and availability, lack of crossing guards, snow removal, and wildlife concerns. Feasibility studies and preliminary engineering will also be conducted in areas already identified as having safety concerns. In addition, reflective sign post panels and signs will be installed at school crossings and school zones to enhance driver awareness and school zone visibility.
