Assembly Resolution for the Appropriation of One Million Five Hundred SUBJECT:

Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$1,512,000) in Federal Highway Safety Improvements Project (HSIP) Funds From a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Memorandum of Agreement with the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA), to the Miscellaneous Capital Project/Pass-Thru Fund (409) Under the Municipal Traffic Department for the Anchorage Area Countdown Pedestrian

Signals Project

The Municipality of Anchorage has accepted a grant in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$1,512,000) in Federal HSIP funds from the ADOT&PF through a Memorandum of Agreement for the Anchorage Area Countdown Pedestrian Signals Project. This grant reimburses the MOA for in-house labor, materials, equipment, traffic control, and the State of Alaska ICAP needed for the project. Work must be completed by December 31, 2010.

Under this agreement, through in-house construction the MOA will purchase and install countdown pedestrian timers and pedestrian pushbutton signs at approximately 256 signalized pedestrian crossings in Anchorage where they do not currently exist. Countdown pedestrian signal timers have been shown to reduce pedestrian-vehicle crashes as well as bicycle-vehicle crashes where the bicyclist is using the pedestrian pathway or sidewalk. The purpose of the HSIP project is to implement a solution that will help to resolve issues contributing to citywide crashes.
