A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND THIRTY-THREE CENTS (\$47,175.33) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF ALASKA STATE TROOPERS AND APPROPRIATING NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$970) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW 2009 OPERATING BUDGET (FUND 101) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) TO ADMINISTER THE ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE PROGRAM

The Department of Law is administering an Anti-Gang Initiative Program (Program). The grant partially offsets the cost of the program. The attached resolution appropriates the 2009 grant from State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, Division of State Troopers and a contribution from 2009 Operating Budget of the Department of Law to fund the Program.

The Anchorage Police Department (APD) documented Anchorage's growing gang problem. APD initiated a five-part program to aggressively prevent and crack down on gang violence. Some of the new police officers added to the force over the last few years are focused on the problem of gangs and related crimes of guns and drugs. However, there is a growing backlog in the Alaska Court System in processing the cases. According to the District Attorney for the State of Alaska, there are more than 2,500 felony cases awaiting disposition in Anchorage, including many gang cases. Delays in processing mean the release of gang members into the community on bail.

Former U.S. Attorney, now U.S. District Court Judge Timothy Burgess proposed a partnership between the Municipality of Anchorage and the Office of the U.S. Attorney to help combat this problem. At Burgess' invitation, the Municipality assigned the Program to the U.S. Attorney's office. The Program is a staff specially trained in prosecution under federal laws, focusing primarily on gang-related crimes. Gang members prosecuted under federal law typically are processed more quickly, with more severe consequences, than under state
