Phase 1 included the construction of the 11,000 square foot AnchorRIDES paratransit administration building built adjacent to the old People Mover Shop and was substantially completed in late 2008 and opened for operation. This new operations and maintenance facility has improved the efficiency of the transportation service for senior citizens and people with disabilities. In 2007 Phase I was competitively bid as a Design/Build contract and awarded to Corvus Construction to construct the new AnchorRIDES administration building and begin remodel of the old People Mover shop with a new fire sprinkler system. Phase II was completed in 2008 and allowed for the facility to be placed in service. Additional FTA funding is available and it is in the Municipality's best interest to complete the remodel of the facility that will result in further cost savings and more efficient operations of the AnchorRIDES program.

The funds to be expended for Phase III will allow for wash facility construction, vehicle parking and related safety and access needs. The remodel work is essential for full functionality of the old People Mover Shop that is approximately 30 years old. These improvements are necessary for safety reasons, to meet industry standards and to reduce operating costs.

The required local match of sixty-four thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$64,750) will be provided from appropriated and voter approved 2008 General Obligation Bonds.
