1 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE SOA FY09  
2 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION  
3 METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE RELATIVE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF  
4 FISHERIES BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA

7 WHEREAS, AS 29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the SOA FY09 Shared Fisheries  
8 Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of Commerce, Community, and  
9 Economic Development that the municipality experienced significant effects during calendar year 2007 from  
10 fisheries business activities;

11  
12 WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding to eligible  
13 municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of Commerce,  
14 Community, and Economic Development;

15  
16 WHEREAS, 3 AAC 134.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the Department of Commerce,  
17 Community, and Economic Development, of alternative allocation methods which may be used within  
18 fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree to use the method, and the  
19 method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of fisheries business activity on the  
20 respective municipalities in the area;

22 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage proposes to join all other participating municipalities within the  
23 Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area in an alternative allocation method for SOA FY09;



25 WHEREAS, such alternative allocation shall be fifty percent (50%) divided equally and fifty percent (50%)  
26 divided on a per capita basis.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly Resolves:



30 **Section 1.** That the alternative allocation method is certified and fairly represents the relative  
31 distribution of significant effects during 2007 of fisheries business activity in the Cook Inlet Fisheries  
32 Management Area.

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34 **Section 2.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

**SUBJECT:** A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALTERNATIVE ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE SOA FY09 SHARED FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION METHOD FAIRLY REPRESENTS THE RELATIVE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF FISHERIES BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA

The Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program was created by the Legislature in 1991. The program provides for sharing of state fish tax collected outside municipal boundaries with municipalities that have been affected by fishing industry activities.

Anchorage is located in the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area. Other municipalities located in this area are Homer, Kenai, Kenai Peninsula Borough, Kachemak, Seldovia, Seward and Soldotna. The SOA FY09 program total allocation to be shared within this area is approximately \$61,134. Anchorage's share is estimated to be \$28,185. The alternative allocation methodology is: 50% divided equally between all the municipalities applying and 50% divided on a per capita basis.

To participate in this program, the municipal governing body is required to approve a resolution requesting funding using the alternative allocation method.
