The attached Resolution re-appropriates \$700,000 of areawide CIP Fund 401 Public Facilities General Obligation Bond Proceeds as a contribution to the Anchorage Parks and Recreation CIP Fund 461 to provide additional funding for Anchorage pool facility rehabilitation projects.

On April 1, 2008, voters approved an Areawide bond proposition for Public Facilities in the amount of \$6,900,000. The projects funded by the bond include improvements at the Anchorage Museum (existing), Sullivan Arena, and various Anchorage Municipal libraries. The Sullivan Arena improvement project has experienced favorable bid prices resulting in significant project savings from original cost estimates.

On April 1, 2008, the voters also approved a bond proposition in the amount of \$2,000,000 in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area to repair and upgrade various swimming pools. Some of these projects are underway. During the course of the various pool repair projects, unforeseen problems have been uncovered that require attention. Old roof leaks, high humidity, saturated insulation, delamination of the epoxy liner from the concrete and the corrosive nature of the pool chemicals have created building problems requiring more extensive repairs than previously indentified. We anticipate the Anchorage Parks and Recreation CIP bond proceeds will only be sufficient to complete the originally planned pool repairs and upgrades.

All of the needed improvements to the Sullivan Arena will be completed well under original cost estimates. Bond counsel has agreed that unexpended bond proceeds can be reallocated to other facilities as long as the improvement projects identified in the associated bond proposal have been provided for. The Sullivan Arena also has a facility reserve account sufficient for minor repairs and upgrades. The recently discovered pool problems warrant a higher Department priority so the repairs can be rolled into current project timelines, and minimize mobilization costs and pool closures at a later date. Currently, the savings from the Public Facilities bond appears to be the only potential source of funding sufficient enough to fund all of the needed repairs. As a result, the Department seeks approval of re-appropriation of \$700,000 of the Areawide Public Facility bond proceeds as a contribution to the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area to provide funding for completion of the additional required repairs.
