A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING EIGHTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY NINE DOLLARS (\$18,829) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, AND CONTRIBUTING SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY NINE DOLLARS (\$679) FROM ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) ANCHORAGE POLICE 2009 OPERATING BUDGET TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL CIP FUND (401), MUNICIPAL MANAGER DEPARTMENT, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THIS FY2008 REALLOCATED STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FUNDING.


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of EIGHTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY NINE DOLLARS (\$18,829) be appropriated from the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to the Areawide General CIP Fund (401), Office of Emergency Management for this FY2008 Reallocated State Homeland Security Grant funding.

Section 2. That the sum of SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY NINE DOLLARS (\$679) is appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151), Anchorage Police Department 2009 Operating Budget as a contribution the Areawide General CIP Fund (101), Municipal Manager Department, Office of Emergency Management.


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Appropriation of State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management FY2008 Reallocated State Homeland Security Grant Funding and Contribution of Local Match. (\$19,508)

The Municipality of Anchorage, Office of Emergency Management has received from the Office for Domestic Preparedness through the State of Alaska, FY2008 reallocated SHSP grant funding to enhance security and preparedness for terrorist prevention. Appropriation of grant and required local matching funds is requested to the Areawide General CIP Fund (401).

Grant funds awarded will provide for the purchase of additional Motorola Project 25 Compatible Interoperable Mobile Radios for the Anchorage Police Department.

FY2008 Reallocated State Homeland Security Program Grant funds will be administered by the Municipal Manager Department, Office of Emergency Management. A special condition of this grant is that the department contribute funds to support associated indirect grant costs. The total projected municipal cost is \$679 which is funded through a contribution from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151). This grant began on October 1, 2008 and will end on December 31, 2010.
