7 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



3 **Subject:** APPROPRIATION OF NINE THOUSAND SIXTY-THREE DOLLARS  
4 (\$9,063) FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO  
5 THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241), FOR THE AIR  
6 QUALITY PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND  
7 HUMAN SERVICES.  
8

9 The Environmental Protection Agency has provided an additional \$9,063 in federal  
10 funding to the Department of Health and Human Services Air Quality Program, adding to  
11 the original grant of \$270,390 and local contribution of \$646,000 for the period January 1,  
12 2009 through December 31, 2009. This funding will help support air quality monitoring,  
13 enforcement and planning activities for the remainder of the grant year.  
14

15 The Department of Health and Human Services operates an air quality program consistent  
16 with federal, state and local regulations. Staff maintains an ambient air monitoring system  
17 for carbon monoxide and particulate matter, enforces local code, issues air quality operating  
18 permits, responds to air quality complaints, analyzes air quality data, and issues air quality  
19 reports and advisories. Staff also performs air quality modeling analyses required by the  
20 Federal Highway Administration for AMATS transportation planning.
