1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE 2010
2 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, WHICH
3 CONSTITUTES THE APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND
4 URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
5 GRANT (CDBG), THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME),
6 AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG). THIS RESOLUTION SEEKS TO
7 APPROPRIATE THE ANNUAL ENTITLEMENT GRANTS FROM HUD, PROGRAM
8 INCOME AND RECAPTURED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION EIGHT
9 HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS
10 (\$1,888,650) OF 2010 PROJECTED CDBG ENTITLEMENT, EIGHTY-FIVE
11 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$85,000) OF PROJECTED CDBG PROGRAM INCOME
12 FUNDS AND SEVENTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$70,440)
13 IN RECEIPTED CDBG PROGRAM INCOME FUNDS, ONE MILLION EIGHTY-ONE
14 THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (1,081,372) OF 2010
15 PROJECTED HOME ENTITLEMENT, FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000) OF
16 PROJECTED HOME PROGRAM INCOME/RECAPTURED FUNDS, AND NINETY
17 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) OF 2010 ESG ENTITLEMENT, AND TO
18 APPROPRIATE TO SAID FUNDS TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS
19 FUND (241) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NEIGHBORHOODS.

20
21 WHEREAS, extensive research and analysis was used to complete the 2008-2012
22 *Municipality of Anchorage Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan*
23 *(Consolidated Plan)*, which is the basis for a comprehensive approach to address the housing
24 and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods; and

25
26 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage will submit its annual application and *Housing*
27 *and Community Development 2010 Annual Action Plan (2010 Action Plan)* of the
28 Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD),
29 outlining the program of activities to be undertaken with Community Development Block
30 Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and Emergency Shelter
31 Grant (ESG) funds; and

32
33 WHEREAS, throughout the development of said application and the *2010 Action Plan*, the
34 Municipality of Anchorage actively sought participation of residents and representatives of
35 lower income Anchorage neighborhoods, including community councils; and

1 WHEREAS, the *2010 Action Plan* was made available to the public on August 3, 2009,
2 public testimony on said application and *2009 Action Plan* was heard before the Housing and
3 Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission on May 13, 2009, a second public
4 hearing was held on August 12, 2009, and written comments on the Plan were accepted
5 through September 3, 2009; and

6
7 WHEREAS, the HAND Commission made a recommendation to the Assembly to approve
8 the *2010 Action Plan* on September 9, 2009.

9
10 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

11
12 Section 1. The Assembly adopts the *2010 Action Plan* of the *Consolidated Plan* as the
13 general basis of a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community
14 development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods and the application for
15 applicable federal grants.

16
17 Section 2. That the subject grants from HUD for the PY2010 distribution are projected
18 CDBG funds in the amount of \$1,888,650 with projected CDBG program income funds
19 receipted in the amount of \$155,440 and the projected PY2010 HOME entitlement funding
20 in the amount \$1,081,372 with projected HOME program income/recaptured funds in the
21 amount of \$50,000 for a total HUD entitlement projection of \$3,175,462 is hereby
22 appropriated, with final funding approval expected from HUD in February 2010, to the
23 Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241), Department of Neighborhoods. PY2010 funding is
24 contingent on final allocation approval by HUD .

25
26 Section 3. That the subject grant from HUD for the PY2010 allocation of projected ESG
27 funds in the amount of \$90,000 is hereby appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund
28 (241), Department of Health and Human Services, contingent on final approval by HUD
29 expected in February of 2010.

30
31 Section 4. That the allocation of said grant funds will be based on the activities outlined in
32 the attached Assembly Memorandum, and in the *2010 Action Plan* of the *Consolidated Plan*.
33 Accounting information is outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, Attachment A.

34
35 Section 5. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval
36 by the Anchorage Assembly.

Subject: ADOPTION OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 2010 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (2010 ACTION PLAN) AND APPROPRIATING PROGRAM INCOME/RECAPTURED FUNDS AS WELL AS PROGRAM YEAR (PY) 2010 ENTITLEMENT GRANTS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME), AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG) TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2010 ACTION PLAN.

The purpose of the attached resolution is to adopt the *2010 Action Plan* and appropriate program income and projected PY 2010 entitlement funds. The *2010 Action Plan* constitutes the Municipality of Anchorage's application for U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement funds for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG). The *2010 Action Plan* is the third of five annual action plans as part of the *2008-2012 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan*.

The 2010 program year begins on January 1, 2010. The *2010 Action Plan* will be submitted to HUD by November 15 after approval by the Assembly, and HUD may review the *2010 Action Plan* for 45 days before final approval. PY 2010 entitlement funds identified in this document are based on projected grant awards as HUD has not yet released the actual 2010 entitlement award amounts. Consequently, all PY 2010 entitlement amounts are contingent on actual awards as announced by HUD, and actual award amounts may require return to the Assembly for appropriation of additional funds.

The *2010 Action Plan* outlines an agenda of activities to be undertaken during the program year to address needs of the Municipality's lower-income residents and identifies potential resources available in the community to undertake these activities. The *2010 Action Plan* was developed by the Department of Neighborhoods (DoN) in collaboration with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission, other organizations and private citizens. CDBG and HOME grants are managed by DoN of the Office of Community Planning and Development. The ESG grant is managed by DHHS.

Consistent with federal regulations, a discussion for input on the *2010 Action Plan* was held in advance of the draft, during the HAND Commission's regularly scheduled May 13th meeting. The availability of the draft *2010 Action Plan* for public comment was noticed

through the *Anchorage Daily News* and through an electronic mailing on August 3rd. Comments were taken in-person during a public hearing on August 12th, and written comments were accepted through September 3rd. All comments were considered in the final draft of the *2010 Action Plan* and in the HAND Commission recommendation; responses to public comments are included in the Plan. Copies of the final drafts of the Plan were included as Attachment B to this Memorandum (sent through the Municipal Clerk's office).

The Department of Neighborhoods, Office of Community Planning and Development, requests approval of the attached resolution to approve the *2010 Action Plan* and appropriate program income and CDBG, HOME, and ESG entitlement funds. Details on the sources and uses for each of these grants are included in the tables below. Additional descriptions of each activity are included in the *2010 Action Plan*, Appendix C.
