A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, APPROVING A SANITARY SEWER MAIN EXTENSION IDENTIFIED AS THE PUMP STATION 53 (SANITARY) SEWER EXTENSION AND PROVIDING FOR ASSESSMENT OF BENEFITED PROPERTIES AT TIME OF SERVICE CONNECTION

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385 and AMC 19.80 mandate that when a main line extension will create, or has the potential of creating, any charge or assessment against the adjacent property, the extension may not be constructed unless the legislative body of each municipality through which the extension passes has approved the extension; and

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385.C.3 mandates that a lien or encumbrance may not be levied against the property for the construction of the extension, unless the property owner connects to the extension; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU), plans to construct a sanitary sewer extension in the public right-of-way of Lake Street in Eagle River, Alaska. This project will eliminate bypass overflows and upgrade the station to current standards; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the sewer line will specially benefit and provide sewer service to two (2) properties previously not benefited, and in doing so will create potential assessments against them; and


WHEREAS, at its November 4, 2009 meeting the AWWU Authority Board supported this resolution, now, therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. It is in the best interest of the community that said sewer main improvements proceed.

Section 2. AWWU shall keep an accurate account of all costs of the sewer main improvements.

After the sewer main improvements have been completed and the costs of the sewer line approved, the Mayor shall cause the computation of all applicable assessment charges. Section 4. At such time as the property cited on the attached assessment roll connects to the sewer main, the respective pro-rata assessment for the sewer line shall be levied in accordance with Municipal Codes and the Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff in effect at the time. Section 5. A special assessment Collection Charge, as authorized in Rules Section 7.4 of the Anchorage Wastewater Utility Tariff, in effect at the time the assessment is levied, will be charged to those properties identified in this resolution. All affected property owners have submitted affidavits which state their non-13 opposition to approval. 14 15 The Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) plans to construct a sewer main 16 extension in the public right-of-way of Lake Street in Eagle River, Alaska. This project will 17 eliminate bypass overflows and upgrade the station to current standards. Construction of this 18 main will make public sewer service available to two (2) parcels. 19 20 Initially, all costs to construct the proposed sewer main extension shall be born by AWWU. 21 When these newly benefited and previously unassessed parcels connect to the sewer main, 22 AWWU shall recover a pro-rated share of its costs through the Levy Upon Connection 23 assessment procedures as authorized by the current Municipal Codes and Utility Tariff. 24 The properties benefiting from proposed construction, and subject to future assessments and 25 26 charges, are identified on the proposed assessment roll, which is made part of the resolution 27 carried by this memorandum. As each previously unassessed property seeks connection, the parcels' pro-rated share of assessable sewer main costs will be presented to the Assembly for 28 confirmation of levy action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AWWU Tariff 29 30 in effect at the time of connection. 31 32 Owners of benefited property were notified of the estimated project cost, and their individual 33 property's estimated cost allocation by certified mail on August 31, 2009. Property owners 34 were invited to meet with AWWU at a time convenient for them for further information and 35 discussion. 36 37 The passage of this resolution will have fiscal impact on one municipal owned parcel. 38 Legal Description Lateral Est.
