Section 2. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or other document required by the United States Department of Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. **Section 3**. Under the provisions of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) Federal Transit Administration (FTA) planning grants are awarded to the State of Alaska. Following the grant award from FTA, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, develops a TORA which 'passes through' FTA funds to the Municipality of Anchorage. The amount of this TORA using the 2008 Section 5303 apportionment for the transit planning program is \$289,394. required local match for the 2008/9 program is \$72,349 and is to be funded from the Public Transportation Department's 2009 operating budget as a cash contribution to the grant.

The grant supports the continuing, comprehensive and cooperative transit planning activities by the Public Transportation Department described in the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). The period of performance will be from the award date until completion and no further obligation of funds are planned after 12/31/2010.
