AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.05.050 TO ELIMINATE COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF MUNICIPAL BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.05.050 is amended to read as follows:

4.05.050 Compensation of members.

A. Except as otherwise provided in the code, no member of a municipal board or commission shall receive compensation for attendance at regular or special meetings.

[ADVISORY BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS. VOTING MEMBERS OF ADVISORY BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS SHALL RECEIVE \$20.00 PER MEETING FOR ATTENDANCE AT EACH REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OR COMMISSION.]

- [B. REGULATORY OR ADJUDICATORY BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS. EACH MEMBER OF A MUNICIPAL BOARD OR COMMISSION DETERMINED BY THE ASSEMBLY TO BE PREDOMINANTLY REGULATORY OR ADJUDICATORY IN NATURE SHALL BE PAID \$50.00 FOR EACH REGULAR MEETING AND SHALL RECEIVE \$40.00 FOR EACH SPECIAL MEETING. THE BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS WHICH ARE DETERMINED TO BE PRIMARILY REGULATORY OR ADJUDICATORY IN NATURE ON THE DATE OF THE PASSAGE OF THE ORDINANCE CODIFIED IN THIS SECTION ARE AS FOLLOWS:
