**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AND MAYOR  
DAN SULLIVAN RECOGNIZING AND HONORING ALASKA'S 2010 WINTER  
OLYMPICS ATHLETES.**

WHEREAS, the 2010 Winter Olympic Games will be held in Vancouver, British Columbia on  
February 12-28 with seven athletes from Alaska representing the 49th state; and

WHEREAS, these seven athletes are from four Alaska communities including Anchorage,

state's best athletes before a global audience.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:
