The 9 program provides for sharing of state fish tax collected outside municipal boundaries with 10 municipalities that have been affected by fishing industry activities. 11 12 Anchorage is located in the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area. Other municipalities 13 located in this area are Homer, Kachemak, Kenai, Kenai Peninsula Borough, Seldovia, 14 Seward and Soldotna. The SOA FY10 program total allocation to be shared within this area 15 is approximately \$59,641. Anchorage's share is estimated to be \$27,470.
