To appropriate the sum of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$168,943) from AWWU Fund (550) and ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$168,943) from SWS Fund (563) as contributions to the HLB Capital Fund (421) for the Girdwood Industrial Park Ruane Road Improvements project.

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



> 3 day of JEPTPM 2008, by This will constitute an agreement made and entered into this A and between the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU), Solid Waste Services (SWS), Heritage Land Bank (HLB) and the Project Management and Engineering Department (PM&E), in regards to work to be completed on behalf of AWWU, SWS, and HLB within the project limits of the PM&E project identified as Girdwood Industrial Park - Ruane Road Improvements (the Project).

Project Scope of Work

PM&E's scope of work includes furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, supervision, and other facilities necessary to successfully complete the work set forth in the Drawings and Specifications. PM&E will advertise and request bid proposals for construction of the Project. Each of AWWU's, SW\$'s, and HLB's portion of the cost will be one-third (1/3) of the total Bid Proposal of the PM&E scope of work. PM&E will recommend award of a construction contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Project Impacts to AWWU, SWS and HLB, and Assignment of Cost Responsibilities

All Items will be constructed in accordance with the Contract Documents and MASS unless otherwise specified in Special Provisions provided by AWWU, SWS, and HLB to PM&E.

Reference MASS SECTION 10.04 SCOPE OF WORK, Article 4.15 Utilities In the event that relocation of utilities becomes necessary as a result of the Project, the parties shall be notified immediately. AWWU and SWS will review appropriate asset relocation costs with PM&E and AWWU and SWS will relmburse PM&E on its 1/3 share of relocation costs determined to be impacted by the Project. If other non-AWWU and SWS utility relocations are necessary because of this project, AWWU, HLB and SWS will contribute equally to the utility relocation expenses.

Reference MASS SECTION 10.05 CONTROL OF WORK, Article 5.14 Dutles of Inspectors AWWU, SW\$, and HLB will each be responsible for one-third (1/3) of all costs associated with pre-construction, construction, and post-construction inspection service labor charges.

The Project will provide for the construction of road improvements and other related work listed as a schedule of Items from the PM&E construction work. AWWU, SWS, and HLB shall each reimburse PM&E fully for one-third (1/3) of the road improvements and other related construction work.

Changes to the Scope of Work and Unforeseen Events

Effort has been made to minimize or avoid unforeseen conflicts with AWWU water and sanitary sewer improvements and SWS facilities. In the event conflict at some location(s) occurs during construction, resolution of conflicts shall be made in accordance with MASS.

Unforeseen events that result in a proposed change order will be addressed to the PM&E Project Engineer. Upon receipt, PM&E will coordinate with AWWU, SWS, and HLB on action to be taken and cost allocation. Any proposals for change orders related to the construction work must be agreed upon between AWWU, SWS, HLB and PM&IE. This may include scope, cost, and schedule, prior to PM&E authorizing the construction contractor to proceed with change order work. Change order proposals will be coordinated through respective points of contact: Todd C. Jacobson, The Boutet Company (522-8776); Tom Winkler, AWWU (564-2785); and Mark Madden, SWS (343-6279), William M. Mehner (or delegate), HLB (343-4334).

Unforeseen events may require this agreement to be amended. This agreement shall only be amended, modified or changed by writing, executed by authorized representatives of AWWU, SWS, HLB and PM&E.

AWWU, SWS, HLB, and PM&E acknowledge the following as authorized representatives on any subsequent amendments:

Estimated Reimbursement of Costs

Bids for the Project were opened on August 26, 2008 (Invitation to Bid No. 28-C061) and SeaCoast Construction is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The unit price work is addressed in "Schedule A – Roadway Improvements" for \$505,171, AWWU, SWS, and HLB shall each reimburse PM&E fully for one-third (1/3) of the construction work based on actual costs. For this project, AWWU, SWS, and HLB each agrees to accept a Journal Entry generated

by PM&E to transfer one-third (1/3) of the Schedule-A-bid amount of \$595,171 from AWWU, SWS, and HLB to PM&E. At the end of the project, AWWU, SWS, HLB and PM&E will reconcile actual construction-costs.

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PM&E Pay Estimates to Construction Contractor and PM&E Billings to AWWU, SWS, HLB

AWWU's, Project Manager, SWS's Mark Madden, and HLB's, William Mehner (or delegate) and The Boutet Company's, Todd C. Jacobson will coordinate to confirm completed construction progress prior to PM&E making payment to the contractor for AWWU, SWS, and HLB improvements construction.

Deliverables:

PM&E shall deliver the following to AWWU, SWS, and HLB:

1. Bid documents (5 hard copies).

2. Bid tabulations (electronic copy - MS Excel format).

3. Contractor pay estimates.

4. Change orders (for any field changes).

5. Additional field documentation related to improvement work, as applicable.

PM&E's inspector's notes for pre-construction and post-construction walk-through inspections and AWWU and SWS facility adjustments.

7. Waivers secured for exceptions to codes, statutes, administrative codes, etc.

8. Contractor redline drawings, signed Record Drawing mylars (for AWWU and SWS betterment work or changes made to any AWWU or SWS facilities, signed by contractor, within 90 days of final completion).

9. Final pay estimate and confirmation of no further charges.

AWWU and SWS shall deliver the following to PM&E:

1. Additional field documentation related to AWWU and SWS improvements work, as applicable.

AWWU's and SWS's inspector's notes for pre-construction and post-construction walkthrough inspections and AWWU and SWS facility adjustments.

Final Payment:

When the above referenced deliverables have been received and approved by AWWU, SWS, and HLB, PM&E will reconcile actual construction costs and transfer dollars to balance the books.
