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## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The sum of Four Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-six Dollars (\$439,476) is hereby appropriated from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund to the Project Management and Engineering Department within the State Categorical Grant Fund (231) for the Salmon Habitat Restoration Program in the Department of Project Management & Engineering.

ENGINEERING.

In 2005, the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) initiated the Salmon in the City initiative in partnership with multiple state, federal, and private sector partners. Several projects are underway to restore riparian habitat, reduce barriers to fish passage, and increase stewardship of aquatic resources. Community benefits of these projects include improved water quality, improved drainage and flood control, and protection of public and private property from eroding creek banks. As a result of these projects and programs, the MOA has received additional funding for the Salmon Habitat Restoration program. This additional funding will implement specific habitat restoration and monitoring programs including:

1) Monitor fish passage in Chester Creek.

- 2) Implement stream bank restoration projects with Youth Employment in Parks.
- 3) Replace the following culverts on Little Campbell Creek with properly installed and sized culverts:
  - a. Culvert #105. Atkins St. and South Fork Little Campbell Creek south of 84<sup>th</sup> Ave.
  - b. Culvert #99. Dimond Hook and South Fork Little Campbell Creek.
  - c. Culvert #102. 88<sup>th</sup> Ave. and South Fork Little Campbell Creek near Little Brook Estates.
- 4) Fund the MOA Creeks Coordinator position to coordinate and administrate salmon habitat related creek and salmon program coordination and administration within the MOA, enhanced monitoring and outcome measurement of Alaska Sustainable Salmon Fund habitat projects, and coordination with the MOA's Watershed and Natural Resources Commission.
