A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING SIXTEEN THOUSAND SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$16,067) IN THE FORM OF A REIMBURSABLE GRANT FROM THE ALASKA RAILROAD THROUGH THE ANCHORAGE PARK FOUNDATION TO THE ANCHORAGE BOWL PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND (461) FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING FENCING TO PROTECT THE BANK RESTORATION IMPROVEMENTS AND TO MINIMIZE TRAIL EROSION ALONG THE SHIP CREEK TRAIL BETWEEN NORTH C STREET AND WEST SHIP CREEK AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Railroad awarded the Anchorage Park Foundation Sixteen Thousand Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$16,067) for the purpose of installing fencing to protect the bank restoration improvements and to minimize trail erosion along the Ship Creek Trail between North C Street and West Ship Creek Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Park Foundation is now granting the Municipality of Anchorage the sum of Sixteen Thousand Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$16,067) in the form of a reimbursable grant to install fencing; now, therefore;

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:


Section 1. The sum of Sixteen Thousand Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$16,067) in the form of a reimbursable grant is hereby appropriated from the Anchorage Park Foundation to the Anchorage Bowl Parks and Recreation Service Area Capital Project Fund (461) for the purpose of installing fencing to protect the bank restoration improvements and minimize trail erosion along the Ship Creek Trail between North C Street and West Ship Creek Avenue.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
