A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY STATING ITS PROTEST REGARDING A TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF A BEVERAGE DISPENSARY/TOURISM LIQUOR LICENSE # 10 FOR ALLEN HENRY CHOY, LLC dba AL'S ALASKAN INN, LOCATED AT 7830 OLD SEWARD HIGHWAY AND AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL CLERK TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTION.

WHEREAS, Allen Henry Choy, LLC has made an application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board [AND HAS PAID THE REQUIRED FEE] for a transfer Beverage Dispensary/Tourism Liquor License # 10, to be used for Al's Alaskan Inn, located at 7830 Old Seward Highway, Anchorage, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, this transfer arises from the transfer of ownership in Allen Henry Choy, LLC, to another family member and the LLC will remain the owner of the License; and

- 2. Taxes owing to the Municipality of Anchorage including real property and personal property taxes, with interest, as more fully set forth in the proof of claims filed by the Municipality in the bankruptcy filed by Allen Henry Choy, LLC [IN THE AMOUNT OF 20.594.74]; and
- 3. Anchorage Fire Department approval was received on May 27, 2010; and
- 4. Administrative site plan review, required by AMC 21.50.500, has been completed; and
- 5. Approvals from the Municipal Health & Human Services and Building Safety Departments **have been received**; <u>and</u>

WHEREAS, conditional protest by the Assembly is in order pending Municipal Clerk confirmation that outstanding items required for this location have been completed; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Anchorage Assembly hereby enters its <u>CONDITIONAL</u> <u>PROTEST</u> for a Transfer of Ownership for Beverage Dispensary/Tourism Liquor License #10 until these conditions are met:

 a. Real property and personal property taxes with interest, but excluding penalties, in the amounts and as provided for under the Debtor's First Amended Confirmed Ch. 11 Plan (Classes 2 and 3) are paid in full [TAXES PAID IN FULL].

<u>Section 2.</u> A copy of this Assembly Resolution may be presented to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as proof that the Anchorage Assembly, as the local governing body, has stated its <u>conditional</u> protest in order to allow the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to hold processing of Beverage Dispensary/Tourism Liquor License #10 under local protest <u>pursuant to AS 04,11,480(c)</u> until receipt by the Director of confirmation from the Municipal Clerk that the conditions in Section 1 have been met, and this <u>conditional</u> protest is lifted as authorized by this Assembly Resolution.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Anchorage Assembly hereby authorizes the Municipal Clerk, upon Municipal Clerk confirmation that all conditions in Section 1 have been met, to provide written notification to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board that this <u>conditional</u> protest by the Anchorage Assembly is lifted, without further action by the Assembly.

Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
