A RESOLUTION ADOPTING SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NUMBER FOUR (4) TO THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 2010 ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Assembly adopted and appropriated funding for the Housing and Community Development 2010 Action Plan (HCDA Plan) of the 2008-2012 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan on November 17, 2009 under Assembly Resolution No. 2009-258; and

WHEREAS, the HCDA Plan requires Assembly approval of a substantial amendment for projects not specifically identified in the 2010 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development accepted the Municipality's HCDA Plan on January 5, 2010, allowing the Municipality to receive its annual allocation; and

WHEREAS, the HCDA Plan identified 2009 prior uncommitted funds of \$29,134 and projected funds \$31,500 of Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Maintenance and Operations for a competitive Request for Grant Proposal (RFGP). HUD subsequently identified 2010 ESG Maintenance and Operations funding of \$29,040; and

WHEREAS the Department of Health and Human Services issued an RFGP and convened an Evaluation Review Committee for the RFGP; and

WHEREAS the proposal ranking results of the RFGP were Rural Alaska Community Action Program, Catholic Social Services, Covenant House Alaska, Abused Women's Aid in Crisis, Inc. and The Salvation Army; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 12, 2010 to hear citizen's comments in front of the Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission (HAND Commission); and

WHEREAS, an advertisement was published in the Anchorage Daily News on May 3, 2010 and emailed to an electronic listserv to announce a 30 day comment period for Amendment #4 to the 2010 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the HAND Commission passed Resolution HANDR 2010-4 in support of these projects; and WHEREAS, the projects funded through the amendment are consistent with the 2010 Action Plan; now, therefore, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES: Section 1. The Assembly adopts substantial Amendment #4 to the HCDA Plan. Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly. Subject: A RESOLUTION ADOPTING SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NUMBER FOUR (4) TO THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 2010

ACTION PLAN.

The resolution amends the Housing and Community Development 2010 Action Plan (HCDA Plan) to include projects identified as a result of a Request for Grant Proposal (RFGP). The Housing and Community Development Consolidated Public Participation Plan requires Assembly approval when projects are modified, added, or substantially amended.

The HCDA Plan identified 2009 funding of \$29,134 and projected 2010 funding of \$31,500 for the Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Maintenance and Operations for a competitive RFGP. However, specific funding for the RFGP was not identified in Plan. The HCDA Plan was developed in accordance with the U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Municipal regulations and adopted by the Assembly on November 17, 2009 (AR-2009-258/AM-575-2009).

2010 ESG Maintenance and Operations funding of \$29,040 was subsequently identified. Under the RFGP a total of five proposals were submitted. An Evaluation Review Committee (ERC) reviewed and ranked all applications and made award recommendations as per the process described in RFP No. 2010-GP001. All awards and allocation are exempt from the completion of an environmental review per 24 Code of Federal Regulations Part 58.

Notification of the 30 day public comment period regarding these awards was posted on May 3, 2010 in the Anchorage Daily News. The Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission accepted public comment for these projects during a meeting held May 12, 2010, and accepted written comment through May 26, 2010. The HAND Commission has adopted a resolution recommending that the Assembly approve the substantial Amendment #4 to the 2010 Action Plan.

Based on approval of this amendment the Department of Health and Human Services intends to make the following grant awards for help with utility costs:
