WHEREAS, Ted Stevens served in the Eisenhower Administration in the Department of the Interior, during which he was a driving force in the monumental effort to admit the then-territory of Alaska into the Union; and

WHEREAS, Ted Stevens served in the Alaska Legislature before being appointed to the United States Senate in 1968; and
