 Ben Boeke Ice Arena was built in the 1970's and is in need of renovations and mechanical and electrical improvements. The original construction contract for Ben Boeke Locker & Toilet Upgrades includes two locker room expansions, minor plumbing, interior finish improvements, and extensive mechanical upgrades including two new roof top units and modern digital control upgrades for the HVAC.

Contract Amendment No. 1 provided betterments to the two locker room expansions, including new thicker metal studs, wall backing reinforcements, additional lights and rubber flooring at a total expenditure amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Seven Cents (\$23,633.57). Funding for this contract amendment was from contingent funds requested in AR 2010-49/AM 93-2010 dated February 16, 2010.

 Contract Amendment No. 2 replaces severely corroded galvanized piping throughout the facility to thirty-two fixtures, three new backflow protection systems to prevent contamination to the building and AWWU, replacement of worn out water tempering system, leaking heating balancing valves, leaking waste piping and snaking forty-two waste fixture lines and the main sewer line. Minor electrical work was required at roof top units. The second floor is in need of worn out carpet replacement. There are additional code upgrades identified by the Municipality and AWWU inspectors that are being addressed. Most of this work is being carefully monitored daily on time and materials with some fixed pricing. The general contractor kept their commitment to having the wet and dry locker rooms ready for use on August 9, 2010.

We are requesting Assembly authorization for Contract Amendment No. 2 not to exceed \$175,000 to the S.R. Bales Construction, Inc.
