**Subject:** A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$5,644) FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR THE AIR QUALITY PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

This appropriation will supplement previous funding of \$478,374 appropriated by the Assembly earlier this year through AR 2010-146 for 2010 air quality program operations. This resolution appropriates an additional \$5,644 in funding for 2010 that recently became available from the Environmental Protection Agency. The grant period is January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.

The Department of Health and Human Services operates an air quality program consistent with federal, state and local regulations. Staff maintains an ambient air monitoring system for carbon monoxide and particulate matter, enforces local code, issues air quality operating permits, responds to air quality complaints, analyzes air quality data, and issues air quality reports and advisories. Staff also performs air quality modeling analyses required by Federal Highway Administration for AMATS transportation planning.
