WHEREAS, from service in the United States Armed Forces to their vital role in the economic destiny of Alaska, from their dedication to social service programs to their contributions to the arts and literary endeavors; Alaska Natives and American Indians have played and continue to play key roles in our destiny; and

WHEREAS, 18% of Alaska's population has identified themselves as Alaska Native or American Indian; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Native and American Indian owned businesses account for at least 10% of businesses in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the ANCSA Regional Association October 4, 2010 report shares the combined financial performance of the Alaska Native Corporations, includes revenues totaling \$6.89 BILLION, employment of 13,848 people in Alaska, and a \$774 MILLION payroll, based on the most current available data (2008);
