Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) FROM THE US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR THE SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM (SART) CENTER THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

The Municipal Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has received a congressionally earmarked grant from the US Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime for the Municipal SART Center. The grant period is November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2012.

The SART Center was established in 2004 as a multi-disciplinary center where forensic nurses, victim advocates, and detectives are all present for the examination of sexual assault victims; which ensures that victims are able to tell their story just once rather than multiple times over multiple hours as in an emergency room setting without coordinated, specialized care protocols. Evidence collected through forensic medical examinations by forensic nurse examiners is essential in Anchorage's effort to reduce and eliminate sexual assault. The funding will cover associated costs for the continued development, and operations of the SART Center.

The three goals identified for this project are: (1) Provide timely, thorough, professional forensic evidence collection, documentation, preservation and processing; (2) Enhance the ability of law enforcement agencies to obtain evidence of and investigate sexual assault; and (3) Enhance the ability of the Department of Law to successfully prosecute cases of sexual assault.
