

8 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



6 FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241)
7 FOR THE SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM (SART) CENTER
8 THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN

12 The Municipal Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has received a
13 congressionally earmarked grant from the US Department of Justice, Office for
14 Victims of Crime for the Municipal SART Center. The grant period is November 1,
15 2010 through October 31, 2012.
16

17 The SART Center was established in 2004 as a multi-disciplinary center where
18 forensic nurses, victim advocates, and detectives are all present for the
19 examination of sexual assault victims; which ensures that victims are able to tell
20 their story just once rather than multiple times over multiple hours as in an
21 emergency room setting without coordinated, specialized care protocols.
22 Evidence collected through forensic medical examinations by forensic nurse
23 examiners is essential in Anchorage's effort to reduce and eliminate sexual
24 assault. The funding will cover associated costs for the continued development,
25 and operations of the SART Center.

27 The three goals identified for this project are: (1) Provide timely, thorough,
28 professional forensic evidence collection, documentation, preservation and
29 processing; (2) Enhance the ability of law enforcement agencies to obtain
30 evidence of and investigate sexual assault; and (3) Enhance the ability of the
31 Department of Law to successfully prosecute cases of sexual assault.
