THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS: That an Advisory Ballot Proposition in substantially the same form as appears in Section 2 below shall be placed on the ballot and submitted to the qualified voters of the Municipality at the regular municipal election of April 5, 2011. **Section 2.** That the proposition shall be presented in substantially the following form: PROPOSITION NO. **ADVISORY VOTE** SHOULD THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE REQUIRE MANDATORY PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR SALE OF ALCOHOL BY PACKAGE LIQUOR STORES? Yes[] No [] Section 3. The proposition contained in Section 2 of this ordinance, presented to the qualified voters residing in the Municipality voting on the question in the election of April 5, 2011, is an advisory vote only. It shall advise the Anchorage Assembly of the voters' preference on mandatory photo identification when alcoholic beverages are purchased at a package liquor store, but no enabling legislation is enacted.
