# AN ORDINANCE CREATING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT 10-10 FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF ALEXANDER AVENUE BETWEEN COLUMBINE STREET AND NORENE STREET, AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN. 

WHEREAS, benefiting property owners requested a petition be circulated for creation of a special assessment district to reconstruct Alexander Avenue, as shown on the map attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed and approved by owners of properties bearing more than fifty percent ( $50 \%$ ) of the estimated assessable costs of the improvements; and

WHEREAS, the public improvements are necessary and of benefit to 42 properties, shown by map (Exhibit A), listed in the petition roll for assessment district (Exhibit B) and legally described as:

- Lots 18-34, Block 8, Thunderbird Terrace \#1 Subdivision
- Lots 13A, 14A, and 15A, Block 9, Thunderbird Terrace \#2 Subdivision
- Lots $1 \mathrm{~B}, 1 \mathrm{C}, 2 \mathrm{~B}, 3 \mathrm{~B}, 3 \mathrm{C}, 4 \mathrm{~B}, 5 \mathrm{~B}, 5 \mathrm{C}, 6 \mathrm{~B}, 6 \mathrm{C}$, and 7B, Block 10, Thunderbird Terrace \#2 Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the property owner-approved estimate for the project is $\$ 2,500,000$, and ten percent ( $10 \%$ ) or $\$ 250,000$ is the estimated assessable amount as prescribed in Anchorage Municipal Code section 19.40.100 B.; and

WHEREAS, the estimated assessments of two property owners were erroneously calculated to be higher than specified by section 19.40.090; and

WHEREAS, changes were made to the estimated assessments for all property owners, and as a result of the correction, none of the changes resulted in an increase of more than $3 \%$, a percentage increase under the $10 \%$ cap allowed by the petition statement; and

WHEREAS, property owners were informed by letter of the corrected estimated assessment; and

WHEREAS, project design was funded with existing bonds, and construction was funded with 2010 Anchorage Roads and Drainage service area bonds; now, therefore,

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Special Assessment District 10-10 (District 10-10), comprised of the properties shown by map on Exhibit A and listed on the petition roll for the assessment district on Exhibit B, is hereby established.

Section 2. The Municipality shall proceed with District 10-10 improvements.
Section 3. The Municipality shall fund this project from available bond funds.
Section 4. Costs assessed to benefited parcels shall be ten percent (10\%) of all project costs, after any state grants are applied to either the total project costs or the property owners' share as specified in the grant language.

Section 5. Assessments levied pursuant to this Ordinance shall be based on parcel access, parcel area, and parcel frontage as determined in the propertyowner shares shown in the petition roll (Exhibit B). The Assembly finds the assessments calculated on this basis are proportionate to the benefit received from the improvements.

Section 6. An account shall be kept of all project costs and, after completion of the improvement, a final assessment roll shall be prepared and presented to the Assembly for the purpose of confirming and levying final assessments.

Section 7. The Mayor forthwith shall cause this Ordinance to be recorded in the office of the Anchorage District Recorder.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Funding is available with approved road bonds. The estimated cost of this project is $\$ 2,500,000$. In accordance with AMC $19.40 .100 \mathrm{~B}, 10 \%$ of this cost, or $\$ 250,000$, is assessable and $90 \%$ or $\$ 2,250,000$ is assumed by the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area bonds. The Expenditure and Revenue information assumes design/construction occurs in 2011 and will be adjusted if construction does not occur in 2011. The debt service of $\$ 217,961.39$ was estimated assuming that $\$ 2,500,000$ in road bonds would be retired over 20 years, with an interest rate of six percent ( $6 \%$ ).

## PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

After completion of the project, property owners will be assessed $10 \%$ of the actual cost, which is estimated at $\$ 250,000$. Assessments will be in the manner as stated on the attached petition roll, with annual estimated revenues of $\$ 25,951.39$.

A petition for reconstruction of Alexander Avenue between Columbine Street and Norene Street through the Road Improvement District (RID) program was approved, per Anchorage Municipal Code section 19.20.020, by property owners representing over 50\% of the estimated assessable project costs (Exhibit B). The petition roll includes 26 property owners representing $59.15 \%$ in favor, 6 property owners representing $15.49 \%$ opposed, and 10 property owners representing $25.36 \%$ not responding.
The property owner-approved estimate for the RID improvements is $\$ 2,500,000$. The estimated assessable share is $10 \%$ or $\$ 250,000$, in accordance with the Reconstruction (90/10) Program established in section 19.40.100. Assessment shares for each parcel were calculated with $50 \%$ based on parcel access, $40 \%$ based on parcel area, and $10 \%$ based on parcel frontage, in accordance with section 19.40.090. Property owner assessments were corrected from the assessment amounts on the petition statements owners voted on, resulting in two assessments significantly lower while the remaining assessments increased less than $3 \%$, well under the $10 \%$ cap allowed in the petition.
Improvements are expected to include street and storm drain reconstruction. 2010 local road bonds were provided for the Municipality's $90 \%$ funding share.
