ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2011–66

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.60.057 TO CLARIFY THE PROHIBITION CONCERNING CONVICTION FOR A SEXUAL OFFENSE AND PROVIDING FOR RETROACTIVE APPLICATION TO MARCH 29, 2011, THE EFFECTIVE DATE FOR AO 2011-39.

WHEREAS, Ice Cream Vendors routinely serve ice cream and related products to unaccompanied minors; and

WHEREAS, as with others in our community in immediate and routine proximity to unaccompanied minors, AO 2011-39, effective March 29, 2011, requires a background check as part of the application for an ice cream vendor license and prohibits conviction for a sexual offense; and

WHEREAS, AS Chapter 11.41 provides a benchmark listing of sexual offenses, and the intent of AMC 10.60.057E.1 is to identify, by type, the group of offenses considered to be "sexual offenses" for purposes of ice cream truck vendor licensing; now, therefore

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Anchorage Municipal Code section 10.60.0057, Roving vendors—Licensing requirements, is hereby amended to read as follows (language showing no amendment is set out for context only):

## 10.60.057 Roving vendors--Licensing requirements.

Applicants for a roving vendor license shall provide the following licensing requirements to the municipal clerk's office prior to issuance of a license:

- E. An ice cream truck vendor, and any vendor selling ice cream on a roving basis, shall request a Criminal Justice Information Report (background check), to be mailed or faxed directly from the Department of Public Safety to the Municipal Clerk's office.
  - 1. The applicant shall have no conviction for any sexual offense from any jurisdiction. For purposes of this prohibition, a sexual offense includes the offenses named in [, AS DEFINED WITHIN] Article 4 of Chapter 11.41 of the Alaska Statutes or identified by similar name or

elements under Anchorage municipal code or the law of another jurisdiction, and offenses included as a sexual offense under the law of another jurisdiction. [; AND]

- 2. If vending is from an ice cream truck, the applicant shall have no conviction for driving a motor vehicle while under the influence (DUI) under state or local law within the past 12 months, and no more than one such conviction within five years of the date of municipal license application.
- 3. The requirements and restrictions of this subsection shall apply to the applicant for the municipal roving vendor license and permit to sell ice cream, and any person selling ice cream on a roving basis under the applicant's municipal license. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the background checks, required for each person operating an ice cream truck or selling ice cream on a roving basis on behalf of the licensee, are mailed or faxed directly from the Department of Public Safety to the Municipal Clerk's office.

The licensee shall be responsible for ensuring that all pertinent insurance policies, vehicle registrations, health permits, and licenses required by this section remain current and valid during the license year.
