WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage owns property described as Section 7, T13N, R2W, Lot 9, Ship Creek Water Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, AMC Section 25.10.050 states that the Mayor may in writing designate any municipal agency as the managing authority of a specific parcel of Municipal property; and

WHEREAS, land management authority for this property was designated to Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) in February of 1983; and

WHEREAS, AMC Section 25.30.020 states that disposal of Municipal land or interest therein shall be by ordinance only; and

WHEREAS, AMC Section 25.30.040 states that, notwithstanding exception, all disposals of municipal land shall be for fair market value of the interest disposed of, and the municipality may accept in exchange for municipal land any consideration of sufficient value not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, at its September 7, 2011 meeting the AWWU Authority Board supported Verizon Wireless's request for lease privileges within MOA-AWWU property; now, therefore,


THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> AWWU is authorized to lease ground space on a portion of Section 7, T13N, R2W, Lot 9; to Verizon Wireless, upon the terms and conditions summarized in the Assembly Memorandum submitted to the Assembly with this ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> The lease shall be for a term of (5) five years with (3) three (5) five year renewal periods, subject to mutual consent of both parties. The annual lease payment for each of the years for the first (5) five years shall be \$22,000.00
