1 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING**
2 **ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 26.80 TO INCREASE TIPPING FEES**
3 **FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL.**
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6 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:**
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8 **Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 26.80.050 is hereby amended to
9 read as follows (*the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set*
10 *out*):

12 **26.80.050 - Charges.**

14 A. *Fee schedule for secured loads.* The following solid waste disposal
15 user charges shall apply to secured loads:

18 4. Except as provided in section 26.80.055 or subsection A.6 of
19 this section, at a solid waste transfer or disposal facility that has
20 operational scales, each user who does not meet the
21 requirements of subsections A.1 through A.3 of this section shall
22 have their load weighed and pay the greater of \$15.00 per load
23 or \$56.50 [\$50.00] per ton at the solid waste disposal facility and
24 the greater of \$20.00 per load or \$66.50 [\$60.00] per ton at a
25 solid waste transfer facility.
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27 5. At a solid waste transfer or disposal facility that does not have
28 operational scales, each user who does not meet the
29 requirements of subsections A.1 through A.3 of this section shall
30 pay \$9.00 [\$6.00] per cubic yard of non-compacted solid waste
31 or \$18.00 [\$12.00] per cubic yard of compacted solid waste as
32 measured by the facility attendant

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2 **Section 2.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 26.80.070 is hereby amended to
3 read as follows (*the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set*
4 *out*):

5 **26.80.070 - Surcharges to support community recycling initiatives.**

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9 B. The solid waste disposal utility shall collect a surcharge on all wastes
10 delivered to solid waste transfer or disposal facilities to finance the
11 implementation of these initiatives.

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13 1. Each user delivering waste [on or after April 1, 2009] to a solid
14 waste transfer or disposal facility in quantities weighing less than
15 1,000 pounds, and with a total volume of less than five cubic
16 yards, shall be assessed a surcharge to the existing disposal fee
17 of \$1.00 per visit.

18
19 2. At solid waste transfer or disposal facilities with working scales,
20 each user delivering waste in quantities weighing more than
21 1,000 pounds or with a total volume greater than five cubic
22 yards shall be assessed a surcharge, added to the existing
23 tipping fee, of \$1.50 per ton of waste delivered.

25 3. At a solid waste transfer or disposal facility with no operational
26 scales, each user meeting the requirements of subsection B.1.
27 shall pay a surcharge to the existing tipping fee of:

- 28
29 a. \$0.30 per cubic yard of non-compacted solid waste, as
30 measured by the facility attendant;
31 b. \$0.50 per cubic yard of compacted waste as measured
32 by the facility attendant.

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34 4. [Wastes delivered by a commercial enterprise, collected from
35 established single family and multiple family residential can and
36 bag collection routes, shall be exempt from this surcharge.]
