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17 18 The attached resolution appropriates a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, as funded by the Federal Highway Administration, for the Municipal Share-A-Ride Program in the amount of eighteen thousand seven hundred forty-two (\$18,742). The grant period is January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. No local matching funds are required.

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Share-A-Ride efforts are funded by and required by the Federal Highway Administration to help Anchorage comply with the Federal Clean Air Act. The Share-A-Ride program promotes car pools, van pools and other ridesharing services. Special efforts are directed to major employers. The contracted vanpool management is funded through this grant. Anchorage Share-A-Ride works to improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion by promoting alternatives to driving alone. The vanpool program has grown from 24 vanpool groups in 2005, to 64, resulting in 832 fewer vehicles on the road.
