16 Public Facilities, for the Municipal Share-A-Ride Program to the State
17 Direct/Federal Pass-through Grants Fund (231).

14 The attached resolution appropriates a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement
15 from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, as
16 funded by the Federal Highway Administration, for the Municipal Share-A-Ride
17 Program in the amount of eighteen thousand seven hundred forty-two (\$18,742).
18 The grant period is January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. No local
19 matching funds are required.
20

21 Share-A-Ride efforts are funded by and required by the Federal Highway
22 Administration to help Anchorage comply with the Federal Clean Air Act. The
23 Share-A-Ride program promotes car pools, van pools and other ridesharing
24 services. Special efforts are directed to major employers. The contracted
25 vanpool management is funded through this grant. Anchorage Share-A-Ride
26 works to improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion by promoting
27 alternatives to driving alone. The vanpool program has grown from 24 vanpool
28 groups in 2005, to 64, resulting in 832 fewer vehicles on the road.
